Number of railway stations in the LGA with bike lockers

What is the trend?

Trend data is not yet available. Data which indicates 7 railway stations in the LGA have bike lockers, was first collected in 2009.

The data records the number of railway stations within the Blue Mountains that have bike lockers for public hire. These lockers provide secure storage for bicycles.

Why is monitoring this trend important?

Secure bike storage at railway stations is part of a sustainable transport infrastructure. The provision of low cost lockers to cyclists provides a secure place to store their bike, helmet and clothing. As such these facilities can encourage people to cycle to their local railway station rather than driving and contribute in a small way to reducing car usage.
